

HOW DOES CLIMATE IMPACT DISPLACEMENT?

Climate change and the weather events caused by climate change, are having a *significant* impact in pushing people to move against their will. Millions of people are being forcibly displaced from their homes.

Those who are displaced by climate and weather events don't have the same protections – many will not have the same rights to seek asylum or refugee status as the global infrastructure to support them does not yet exist.
